I am writing to request an additional supply of cyclazocine syrup (1 mg/5 ml) to be sent to the VA Hospital at Northport, to continue the treatment of four patients who are now on cyclazocine.

We have maintained this block of patients without significant difficulty and would like to continue them for an additional 3 to 6 months. We would request two cases (24 x 120 ml/bottle) to be sent to:
