Thank you for sending us the information on fluphenazine decanoate and fluphenazine enathate. My associates, Dr. Itil and Dr. Keskiner have reviewed this information and we are inclined to undertake a trial with fluphenazine decanoate. This impression is based on the findings of Dr. Simpson, indicating that the decanoate produces longer improvement with fewer side effects. Is this impression justified by other data that you might have?

If so, we would be pleased to have you send us the proper investigational forms and supplies of decanoate for our preliminary trial.

I will be available in St. Louis during the month of July and look forward to having you visit.
