Dear Max:

Thank you very much for the SBP Abstract. It is good and I do hope the Committee accepts it.

In making up the table, however, I would suggest that after EEG delta, you insert (3.5 - 5.0 cps) just as you indicated for beta-2, which should read (22 - 33 cps). In the footnote for other tests, it would be clearer to insert after theta, alpha and beta-1, the actual frequencies (5.5 - 7.5), (8.0 - 12.0) and (13.5 - 20.0).

Parenthetically, I recollect that the six subjects who are the basis of the disorganized group were younger in age and may have had some other "social" characteristics different from the remainder. I also recollect that these six patients, if indeed younger, may have had "more abnormal" pre-treatment EEG records. Surely, if they are younger, would they not have more slow wave activity than the non-disorganized group?

I do hope that both your presentation and Don's went well at the divisional meeting. I would be grateful for a copy of each report as read.

With this laboratory now running smoothly, I have more time to review Hillside data. I have reviewed some of this material and
