Dear Costas:

Enclosed is a copy of the critique provided by Dr. Szara, of the summaries submitted for their review at the end of January. Their concerns seem cogant, and I trust we will be able to respond.

My plans to be in Europe in early April are still current. Assuming your availability, I am planning to leave Germany on April 11, arriving that afternoon. I am available until April 15 or 16, as I have a lecture in Washington on April 17.

At a recent meeting, I discussed our publishing needs with Dr. Fritz Freyhan, the editor of Comprehensive Psychiatry. He is allowed to issue "topical issue" volumes, and was interested in publishing all reports in one or two issues of the journal, as well as re-issuing the articles plus appendices as a hard-cover volume. His reception was so favorable that we may consider this as a realistic opportunity.

We are progressing with the data analysis of the withdrawal study, and I am optimistic that I can bring these with me.

I trust you have received confirmation of the presentation before the APA on May 9.
