We have recently been in communication with Dr. Harold K. Rice regarding an appointment at this institute. He has recommended that we consider an application from you for such a position.

This institute has an active program in the analysis of EEG-behavioral relations in man. We have set up a computer center in association with the EEG laboratory. At the present time we are studying the effects of drugs on both EEG and behavior, with both acute and chronic administration.
