Dear Henk,

I have received and read the protocol from Murray Jarvik, and believe that he has expanded his interest in memory mechanisms to encompass the peptides. The protocol is apparently a part of a large application for research support, and I am sure that making OI-63 available should add to the information on the central effects of the peptides. His review of the literature brought out additional references which I will get.

Enclosed is a set of reprints from my earlier work on the effects of drugs (chlorpromazine and imipramine) on various perceptual and attitudinal tasks. For comparison, I am also including the results of induced convulsions (ECT) on these tasks; and when I was deciding on the ones to select, I found one or two additional references that bear on our mutual problems.

Leo Lange is sending Mrs. Rosselson, his technician, to my laboratory next week. Thinking of her visit, I recalled some discussions regarding T. van Lierop-- is there some merit in having him visit ?

It is already June; my staff are thinking about the summer holidays; my daughter Rachel is graduating high school at the end of the month and we face her leaving for the university soon.
