Dear Bob,

Stan has gone over the data you sent him, and has asked me to forward the analysis - which is enclosed. He suggests that the rigorous approach views the data as 3 sets of repeated measures. Because of the small sample size (most probably) neither the analysis of variance F nor the means and 5.0 are significant. If the sample size can be increased, the test should be re-run.

Both he and I made some notations on the interview score sheet. The suggestions are based on the lack of clarity of the item divisions or definitions.
