Dear Dr. Nathan:

My associates and I enjoyed your visit to the Institute last week-end. I am pleased to offer you an appointment as Senior Research Scientist, at the Missouri Institute of Psychiatry, effective on or about July 1, 1965 at an initial salary of \$13,000 per annum. In this appointment, it is anticipated that you will participate in the research programs of the Institute under my direct supervision. W

While it is my understanding that you are eligible for only one more year in the United States as an exchange student, I would be pleased to do whatever I can to assist you to continue your program for a longer period at this Institute; or failing that, to assist you in obtaining a provisional appointment with one of my Canadian associates.

As I explained, the Missouri Institute of Psychiatry is undergoing a transition period at the present time and it is quite probable that the appointment to the Institute will carry with it a concurrent appointment to the Department of Psychiatry of the University of Missouri School of Medicine. At the present time, the positions at the Institute are subject to the regulations of the Division of Mental Diseases which establishes our working week (40 hours), vacation (15 days per year) and such additional perquisites as may from time to time be allowed by the Division Director (Dr. Ulett). In the event that salary adjustments are approved by the Division Director or by the Department of Psychiatry of the University, the stated salary will be adjusted accordingly.

I look forward to having you join the staff of the Institute, and trust that your visit to St. Louis provided you
