Keith and I have been on the phone and the following has been arranged:

1. An invitation was extended to Dr. Don Walter of U.C.L.A. and accepted. His expenses should be paid by the A.C.N.P.
2. Invitations were extended to Drs. E. Roy John, Neil Burch, John Stern and Frank Ervin. These men agreed to participate at their own expense.
3. Reservation requests were sent to Dr. Rothman on behalf of each of these people.
4.
