I am writing with regard to rebudgeting MH-13358-01 and -02 (EEG and Human Psychopharmacology).

In reviewing the expenditures for 1967 there are \$5500 in unexpended funds which may be carried over into 1968. A revised 25-90-1 (Section III) is enclosed. THIS IS UNAUDITED AND COMES FROM MY RECORDS ONLY.

This sum should be used to reduce the award of MH-13358-02.

We have also reviewed the request budget for 1968. You may be aware that MH-13003-02, a grant to complete studies at the University of Missouri runs concurrently from 9/1/67 through 8/1/68. Except for some consultation and travel items, it has not been necessary to utilize this budget and \$9,000 remains. This will be used during the first few months of 1968 and it is suggested that MH-13358-02 be reduced in this amount.

A revised request budget for the -02 year is attached. The sums carried forward and the balance of MH-13003 will be used to reduce the personnel item.

These modifications in the 1968 budget meet with the approval of the executive administrator of the Department of Psychiatry and the Vice President, both of whose signatures appear below.
