I am writing to bring you up to date with regard to Dr. J. Lyons. At the time that you brought him to our attention, Dr. Ulett was in the midst of negotiating with the University of Missouri regarding the transfer of authority for the Missouri Institute of Psychiatry. Within the last week, the many officials who are responsible for this transfer have approved a set of contracts, which now make the Missouri Institute a division of the University of Missouri School of Medicine.

With this transfer of authority, I have been enjoined from establishing new sections within the Institute. It is my anticipation that it may take a number of months before the relationship between the Missouri Institute and the University is sufficiently clear to permit a full dress review of Dr. Lyons' credentials.

I trust that these facts will help explain the ambiguities in our present position.
