I have received your letter of February 6 regarding the relationship between the APPA and Comprehensive Psychiatry. While this problem has been discussed many times, I believe the response of the publisher to Fritz to our recent inquiry is the first time that the publisher has been willing to consider a special subscription rate for APPA members.

The question of editorial policy, the appointment of the Editor, and nominations for the Editorial Board are matters that were discussed. Fritz was able to satisfy the questions of the Council at that time. Subsequent to that meeting, the officers of that period (1972) were appointed to the Editorial Board. The appointment of the Editor, however, seemed outside the purview of the Association.
