Dear Dr. Saito:

I have read your letter with interest and your reprints have been summarized by my associate, Dr. Ikuta. In going over these papers and reviewing the opportunities at the Institute there are two programs in which you could participate. In one, we are establishing a laboratory for EEG and depth electrode studies in animals, primarily the dog and monkey. In this program, a research fellow would devote his major energies in preparing animals, administering various drugs both acutely and chronically and analyze the relation between EEG changes and behavior.

In a second program, Dr. Turan Itil and I are studying the EEG changes with drugs in psychiatric patients. A major part of this program is EEG frequency analyses and we have analyzers similiar to those used by you.

If either program is of specific interest to you, I would like you to indicate this and I will then write to your referees. I am also requesting Dr. Ikuta to write at some length regarding the program and policies of this institution, hoping that this may help you.
