Dear Harold:

I have read the correspondence between George and yourself regarding an agreement between the Curators of the University of Missouri and the Psychiatric Research Foundation.

While I would agree that an understanding between the Dean of the Medical School, the Director of the Division of Mental Diseases, and the Foundation with regard to the facilities of the hospital and the transfer of grants already made would be helpful, any provisions which may limit the fund raising capacities of the Foundation would minimize its long range usefulness. Specifically, a limitation that the Foundation could no longer solicit grants from the Federal Government may be prejudicial to the best interest of the Foundation. It may be to everyone's advantage not to limit the Foundation's activities in any specified way at this early date.
