Dear Ali,

If you receive this letter on your return from Europe without having stopped in New York, please call me. Turan and I spent yesterday afternoon talking about you and Jovan and have volunteered your joint services for two projects, both of which should be completed during October.

We have been invited to make a demonstration of our butaperazine work at the forthcoming Divisional APA Meeting in Chicago, November 15-17. We would like you and Jovan to be prepared to attend the meeting and present the work done in St. Louis and New York. The demonstration will include the EEG-behavioral changes published in Comprehensive Psychiatry, the effects on EEG and the sleep print, and our experiences with liquid Repoise. These are our suggestions. We would like your contribution.

We have been invited to summarize our experiences with long acting phenothiazines for a forthcoming volume on Modern Trends in Psychiatry to be edited by Ted Rothman of Los Angeles. At first he asked for permission to reprint the report in the Archives of General Psychiatry. Jovan, Turan and I think that a better report would be a summary of both studies in Missouri and our study in New York.

If I have not discussed these with you already, please call me as soon as you get this letter so that I can arrange for your return to New York for a work session. I hope you had a nice visit in Turkey and that your family approved of your decision.
