Dear Miss Slotky:

I am returning the text of our report "Long-Acting Depot Phenothiazine Treatment of Psychosis," which is to appear in the forthcoming issue of the *Archives of General Psychiatry*.

Please change the name of the coauthor to Turan M. Itil, M.D.

The address listed is a permanent address.

With regard to the reference now numbered 16, this appears on page eight. The original text is incorrect and reference 15 should be 16.

The personal communication of reference 17 was oral, July 22, 1967.

There are minor corrections in the text on pages 1, 2, 9 and 10.

In Table I, the subscript "years" for average number of hospitalizations is ambiguous. That should be deleted.

In other regards the text appears correct.

Finally, I believe the layout can be improved. The layout shows the report beginning on the left side of the page. This is awkward and if at all possible, perhaps this report should start on the right side. Paragraph two of the results and the figure which now is on page 4 do go together. If we start on a right-hand page then the first paragraphs of the results will appear on a page facing the figure. I would also suggest a realignment of these pages so that the figure and the legend

appear on the upper left-hand side, in the location on page 3 where Table III now appears. By continuing the copy so that it extends on the lower half of the left column and the upper half of the right column, Table III can occupy the lower half of the right column of page 3.

For page 4, Table IV might suitably occupy the upper right-hand part of the page so that the text fills in the left side and all of the left column. The comment would then appear under Table IV and would continue to page 5. It would not be necessary to change page 5.

If the recommendations for page 4 are unsatisfactory an alternate approach is to have Table IV in the lower half of page 4 filling out the right-hand corner, allowing the copy to complete the left side and the upper right part of the page.

The reprint order is enclosed and a formal purchase order will follow.
