Dear Alan:

Earlier this summer, when we were doing our pilot studies of GB-94, I received three bottles of tablets labelled Bottle No. 1, No. 2, and No. 3. Each contained 100 tablets, green, unscored, approximately 7/32" in diameter. The packing number is 658283.

We did not use these tablets in our dose-finding studies, since we changed the design.

Rather than send them back or destroy them, I would be grateful if you could identify the contents of each bottle so that we may use these in our further studies. (One should be 5 mg GB-94, one 10 mg amitriptyline, and one placebo.)
