Dear Dr. Waller:

Thank you for your analysis of our hashish sample. In relation to the THC  $\Delta^9$  content of our marijuana samples, this material should yield greater effects. The NIMH sample contains 1.31% THC, and if THC is an active base for cannabis action, the hashish should give some effects. But your comment about the need for more "pure" samples is well taken and I am writing to Dr. Scigliano to ask for a supply as soon as available.

Dr. Miras' analyses have not yet been received and I will send them to you as soon as I get them.

The need for better defined samples is emphasized by your note, and I am grateful for the comments, and agree.
