We have made all the preparations for the fluphenazine decanoate study in the Mental Hygiene Clinic at Metropolitan Hospital, and would be pleased to start as soon as you can make supplies available.

The suggestion of a comparison of the decanoate and the enanthate forms is quite reasonable, and if the initial experiences with the decanoate appear to go as well as I anticipate, I do not think we would have any difficulty in undertaking a comparison of the two compounds. I would be delighted to discuss this with you.

The draft copy of the report on Prolixin Decanoate is undergoing another revision and I plan to be in St. Louis this weekend. The reports of this first study are complete and I have held them pending the completion of this report. However, I will send them out to you before the report is completed.
