Dear Joyce,

Having finally settled on a publisher, we have edited your contribution to the ECT symposium, *EEG and Neurophysiological Studies of Convulsive Therapies*, according to the style of the volume. There are a number of changes which I have introduced, chiefly:

'Indoklon' is replaced by flurothyl;

for 'shock' and 'electrical stimulation', an appropriate phrase embodying the concept of unilateral electrode placements;

citations updated including Volavka et al (1972) instead of Abrams et al (1970) on page 10, and a fuller citation for Marjerrison; and,

deletion of the last line of the discussion as gratuitous in the written text.

I trust these changes will not be of consequence, but they will allow some greater uniformity of style. Publication date is set for September, and the publisher is V.H. Winston & Sons, who have promised a hot type, hard cover book with a low cost to the buyer.
