SUBJECT: Laboratories for T-1, New School Building

I have reviewed the drawings for T-1, and suggest that teaching and research laboratories be defined and some special features be incorporated in the building as it is completed.

1. Electrophysiology

Beginning with the note that 877 is set aside as an information retrieval facility, I would suggest Laboratory 560 be assigned to the EEG-computer, and rooms 800, 745, and 406 be planned as shielded rooms for polygraphic recording. Should you wish additional laboratories, 405 and 407 can be designated laboratories. Their proximity to the computer for processing may be advantageous.

If such a designation is made, then the following supporting units can be assigned:

Data Processing - #605, 606
Shop - #857
Storage, Equipment Laboratory - #606
Offices - #407, 408, 319, 378, 519, 827

2. Psychiatric Data Processing

For data analysis and statistical work of the Department, you will wish a laboratory for keypunch, calculation, files, data processing terminals. Perhaps 607 should be designated for this use.

3. Library

Rooms 877, 867, 887 remain as designated.

4. Psychology Laboratories

A facility for observation and recording (both audio and visual 'TV') would be useful. Suggest 797 be single interviewing room; 557 a group (large) interviewing room; and 742 as the observer-recording room. This will require cable connections and windows from 742-557-797.

Rooms 597-598-599 should be designated "psychology" laboratories.

5. Biochemistry

Rooms 559, 799, 744, 167 (? 603, 604) could be equipped as laboratories with benches, gas, water, etc. If so, #151 (172 in room list) and 897 can be designated glassware, instrument, and storage rooms.

6. Laboratories to be deleted

If these laboratories meet our anticipated needs, then the laboratory designation for 597, 598, 599, 600, 601, 602, 558 should be deleted, and laboratories 560, 607, 557, 605, 606 be re-designated as outlined above.

Should these suggestions be agreeable, I will outline the special requirements for the rooms designated.
