Dear Mr. Tenley,

Enclosed is a revised contract pricing proposal for the study of naltrexone in "The Evaluation of Narcotic Antagonists" in response to RFP-NIMH-NDA-73-225. This revision is in the amount of \$165,761 for 18 months and represents an extension of HSM-42-70-115.

In making the adjustments requested in our telephone conversation we have:

deleted items representing EEG;

added a laboratory technician for the additional laboratory tests;

provided an allowance for travel for subjects to attend the clinic daily while on outpatient status;

and, increased the nurse from half to full time to provide additional weekend coverage for the added delivery of naltrexone.

We understand that the Project Director has recommended adjustments in our permit, and we agree to comply with his recommendations, subject only to the review of our local CORIHS, should that be necessary.
