Kathy told me of the tape problem. I heartily expected more. I do not have another good tape to send you. I am making arrangements to be in St. Louis on November 11 and 12, and would be pleased if I could go over whatever you have at that time.

Don brought the barbiturate study material and this seemed very good. He has some suggestions as to the next step and probably has already discussed this with you.

We met in Washington to go over the Denber material and we have asked Dr. Bonato to send some of the behavioral data to St. Louis. When it arrives it will be in card format and the same kind of analysis that was done for the EEG samples will probably be done for this data; however, it would be helpful to see a listing and perhaps a simple print-out should first be prepared.

Enclosed is a copy of the final draft of our presentation in Madrid. While you like "Connie" better than "Constance" until you authorize otherwise, it will remain as "Constance." However, you will still have a chance to change it, as I expect the galley proofs in a few months.
