Thank you for the information regarding the progress of the grant application by Dr. Thomas Hanlon (MH 24323). I have read the revised program and believe it is consistent with the recommendations of the site visit team. The present protocol does not require computer equipment and is essentially an assessment of the visual evaluation of the EEG. This type of analysis is well within the competence of the clinical team and should require no expenditures above those listed in the revised budget.

Should this program demonstrate merit, the computer evaluation of the EEG studies could be anticipated some years hence.

With this in mind, I do not think another site visit would be contributory.
