Dear Miss Warner:

Thank you for your interest in the position in St. Louis.

The Missouri Institute of Psychiatry is a research and training center affiliated with the Department of Psychiatry of the School of Medicine at Washington University. It is a research unit very similar to the Maudsley Hospital in London. I am taking the liberty of enclosing a description of the Institute.

At present, there are three laboratories for EEG recording using either the Grass or Offner 8 and 12 channel instruments. There are two electronic analyzers which are in use with these instruments. In addition, the laboratory has established a computer unit for EEG analysis.

Positions are presently available for EEG recordists at an initial salary of \$300-\$330 per month with a recommendation for increments in six months if the work is satisfactory. In addition, we are able to supply training in the use of these specialized instruments for recordists who have not had such experience.

If such a position is of interest to you, I would appreciate the names of two referees, the probable date of beginning such an appointment, and the kind of visa applied for.

I would appreciate your calling Dr. James Margerison at the Maudsley Hospital for any further information regarding the Institute and arrange, if possible, to visit with him in London for his recommendation.
