Your letter regarding an opportunity in research at the New Jersey Bureau of Research was sent to me by Dr. Osmond with the suggestion that perhaps we would have an opportunity here.

The Missouri Institute of Psychiatry is a parallel research center established in St. Louis. Laboratories now exist in psychopharmacology, neurophysiology, computer electronics and clinical psychology. The institute has a three-year residency training program and a postresidency research fellowship program.
