Dear Mr. Shapiro:

This letter is to confirm the understanding we established on Friday, September 25, 1964. It is my understanding that effective October 1, 1964 and until you have been awarded the D. S. C. from Washington University (estimated to be on or about June, 1965) you will be employed by the Psychiatric Research Foundation of Missouri at 80% of the monthly rate of \$900. You will, during this period of time, assume the responsibilities for the direction of the Computer Center of the Missouri Institute of Psychiatry, and continue the research programs which have been mutually agreed upon. It is my understanding that you will continue the relationship with Washington University Computer Center and provide the link between the two institutions.

You are aware that we have agreed to continue a consultative relationship with Mr. Dammkoehler of the Washington University Computer Center and that you are free to use their facilities as our program requires.

Secondly, it is my understanding that you will continue as the Director of the Missouri Institute of Psychiatry Computer Center for a minimum period of one year from the time your degree is awarded. This appointment will be on a full time basis, at an annual salary of \$17,500.

In the event that we are unable to support this appointment during the period 1965-66, I should be able to notify you by the first of June, 1965.

If this letter carries both the spirit and the facts of our agreement, I would be grateful if you would initial a copy and return it to my office.
