I was very much interested in your report on W.H.O. activities in Mexico City. Your comments regarding analgesics and antagonists available from Janssen were most helpful - I discussed these with him, and we have agreed to share our data.

I am enclosing some reports from this laboratory, of our studies of the use of narcotic antagonists in opiate dependence, and the central effects of acute and chronic cannabis use. The cannabis studies are in progress in New York and Athens, and we have a proposal to extend the study to Jamaica.

Many scientists and clinicians from many countries have visited our laboratories, and should W.H.O. desire to extend their training activities, we would be pleased to participate.

Again, my thanks for the suggestion about Janssen.
