Dear Dan:

First, let me thank you for the wonderful set of seminars that you held in San Jose. My associates and I have been busy with both the logic and program of BMD02T. We have been able to assimilate the autocovariance part of the program and during this week have tried to understand the power-spectrum part. Using Herb Jacobs' program, we have been able to write a program for both these analyses for the 1620.

I plan to be in San Francisco from October 2 to the 9th. The best opportunity is for me to fly down on Tuesday, October 8, and work with you that afternoon or evening and Wednesday morning. If that is not satisfactory, I can fly down Friday afternoon and work Friday evening and Saturday. If it is possible for you to set aside some time on either of those periods and obtain some machine time at the WDPC, I would be most grateful. I shall be bringing down three tapes of digitized EEG samples. I should like the opportunity to process parts of these, using the latest modifications of BMD02T.
