Dear Dr. Bernstein,

In preparation for the ECDEU meeting, I have read the report of the ECDEU studies finished and reported June 1969 to May, 1970. One of our studies, that of doxepin-chlordiazepoxide is listed.

In discussing this with Dr. Simeon, he assures me that at least 3 additional reports, Form 22, were submitted during this period:

Thiothixene in anxiety/depression
AHR-1900 in schizophrenia
Ketipramine-imipramine in depression.

Copies of those reports are enclosed, if the originals failed to get to you.

In my recent telephone conversation, I indicated that I intended to request a continuation of the program, MH-13358, "EEG and Human Psychopharmacology" in two parts-- one focussed on EEG and another on ECDEU in juveniles. The ECDEU application, "Psychopharmacology of Juvenile Behavior Disorders" is now at our Research Committee and should be in Washington by June 1. The EEG program application will not meet the June 1 deadline, but will be submitted soon thereafter.

I look forward to seeing you in Boston.
