Dear Bill,

Enclosed are the completed study protocol pages and supporting documents for the study of butaperazine syrup, as maintenance therapy in chronic schizophrenic out-patients. I am enclosing copies of the USPHS forms as we plan to use these in this study.

This study has been approved by the appropriate committees of the New York Medical College and I have only to await the approval of the Commissioner of Hospitals - usually a matter of two to three weeks. The study may be undertaken at that time, or as soon thereafter as we have received the butaperazine syrup.

My staff has made some suggestions regarding the type and size of bottles that may be necessary for these patients. May I ask that you send us a small supply, enough for only a few patients, initially. As soon as we have had some experience in delivering a liquid medication to our patients, I would then like to be able to discuss with you the amount and form of a more definitive supply of the syrup.

Thank you for your assistance with Tybamate. Dr. Fernandez has called me and I have already sent him a copy of the protocol.
