It was a pleasure to have you visit with us this weekend, and I hope that you enjoyed our working together as much as I did.

Kathy retyped your paper within a few hours and Jovan and I have reviewed it and it has been corrected once again. Enclosed is a draft copy for review by yourself and Turan. As we read the article, we found that it followed too closely our usual drug reports and we felt that much of the information regarding psychopathology and laboratory tests detracted from the clinical mission.

We spent a few hours and edited it again. The second version is enclosed and this one seems much more direct and seems to us very good for the JAMA. Would you and Turan please check both versions and make such corrections as you suggest?

In addition, Jovan and I ask whether some additional follow-up data beyond six months might not be inserted on the bottom of page five as regards the patients discharged from the hospital and maintained in the community. This would follow logically the last sentence on the page.

To complete our records, I would appreciate case summaries for the patients added in the final report - those of Italiano, Tucker, Walsh and Caldwell. As soon as I have these and a draft of the report, I believe we can close the record in this first study program of fluphenazine.
