Dear Dr. Broudy:

I am writing to request an additional supply of marijuana for our experimental program supported, in part, under NIMH 18172 and 13358. We have recently completed one study of marijuana and perception in volunteers. A copy of the interim summary is enclosed. In this study we used 46 Grams of marijuana, and have 54 Grams remaining.

In the next study, to begin October 1, 1970, we need 80 Grams minimal, and would prefer 100 Grams to account for repeat sessions and dropouts.

We request an additional 50 Grams of the same marijuana, 2-PF-81 (Mexican female, 1969,  $\Delta^9$ THC=1.5% and cannabidiol, 0.12%). If this is unavailable, we would ask for 100 Grams of equivalent material and return the remainder of 2-PF-81.
