In answer to the questions of your letter of June 30:

1,2: as in letter of June 22. I do not think we really need a second co-chairman for panel 4.

3: A committee meeting probably should be held, but the expenses would make this less possible. I do not see that we are too short in time and perhaps much of the work could be done by mail, as you are now doing it. The decision should rest until winter, when you can appraise the products of our work.
