Dear Lew,

I am sorry that it has taken me so many weeks to track down the notes you requested, but they were in the hands of one of my associates in Missouri and I have just received them. Your original notes are attached.

While we completed studies of cycloserine in psychotic patients, the number of subjects was too small to provide a definite report without additional EEG data. These additional studies were in progress when I left St. Louis and have not been completed. It is the impression of my associate (and also mine) that cycloserine may yet be useful in the symptom provocation treatment of schizophrenia.
