Dear Doctor Gardner,

I would like to amend the IND for cyclazocine by the following addition:

"Challenges" with intravenous diacetylmorphine (heroin) with 25 mg will be done 24 hours after a maintenance dose of cyclazocine has been established. Heroin will be administered in 2 cc saline in one minute. The response will be monitored by interview schedules, pupillography, and respiratory rate. Challenges will be repeated at periodic intervals during the course of treatment in the same laboratory.
