The Program Committee of the 1970 CIMP met in Rome on May 6/7 and discussed the suggestions for symposia and lectures as presented by different delegates and members. All the suggestions made by myself and the Czechs were turned down by the majority of the Committee ! The suggestion of a symposium on EEG models in drug evaluation was also rejected, and no EEG program accepted.

The principal foci will be on neurohumors (including alleged neurohumors), lithium and amphetamine addiction.

Thank you once again for considering my suggestion-- but we will have to find another forum, perhaps another society in the U.S. ?
