Stanley, Rhea Dornbush, Jan Volavka, Richard Abrams and I have read and discussed your report at length. It is an interesting suggestion, that the memory and EEG effects may require hours to "mature". In one group of patients we did try to assess memory changes at 3 hours post-seizure but the study was incomplete, and we are unable to contribute to the hypothesis from these data.

Our recent EEG data does not allow a test of the suggestion. We are writing the protocol for a new study, however, and if we are able, will include some serial EEG recordings to try to answer the question.
