Dear Peter:

I look forward to your visiting my laboratories at Stony Brook on January 17. I understand from your secretary that you will be arriving from Toronto. There are connections to two New York airports, LaGuardia and John F. Kennedy.

The best way to reach the University is by limousine from either airport--travel time is 1-1/2 hours. When you arrive at either airport (LaGuardia is 10 minutes closer), ask for the nearest suburban limousine telephones and use the one marked "Long Island Limousine." They will give you the schedule for the next limousine to Stony Brook and you will be picked up at the terminal, near that phone. Telephones are at each major terminal. The cost is \$15.00.

You may either take a taxi from the limousine depot at Stony Brook or call my number and I will pick you up. (The railroad station and limousine stop are eight minutes from campus.)

Should it be possible for you to change your schedule and arrive the night before, you are welcome to stay at my home and drive to Stony Brook with me. In that event, call me from the airport at (516) 466-5444.
