Dear Dick:

Officially, the grant MH 07072 ends February 28, 1964 and unless we obtain prior approval, it will not be possible for you to make expenditures beyond that date.

As of December 31st, there remains in the grant \$3,639; if we continue the expenditures at the present level, there will remain approximately \$1,900 at the end of the grant.

Do you believe that the project will be completed by February 28th? If so, then I believe no other action on your part is necessary except for you to know that technically we would not be able to pay Lou Masterman, or provide for any of your travel after that date.

If not, then it would be important for you to ask for a second extension explaining such a need. If you think it necessary to write such a letter, please see me on your next trip to St. Louis.
