Dear Dr. Bryant:

Following our conversation of Friday, November 13th, I am enclosing a list of the personnel of the Missouri Institute of Psychiatry with the recommended titles and their curricula vitae. Dr. Ulett has reviewed these and has instructed me to change some of the titles. It seemed inappropriate to recommend basic scientists for academic titles in psychiatry. For this reason, the titles suggested for Drs. Korol, Sundland, Lang and Klein are in their basic discipline "in the Department of Psychiatry".

Insofar as Dr. Gershon has academic standing both as a pharmacologist and psychiatrist, Dr. Ulett believes his titles should be in both departments as originally suggested.

We are struggling with the applications to the National Institutes of Health and I will send them to you as soon as they are completed.
