Dear Leo,

Since March, we have continued the studies under this contract in Greece. We wished to sustain the 'team', and we were encouraged to do so by the interesting data they generated.

1. We authorized the following additional expenditures under the subcontract:

III B-1	Salaries	\$ 7200.
B-5	Patient fees	1500.
B-3	Laboratory costs	280.
B-6	EEG costs	310.

2. In December, 1971, we approved a visit by Costas Stefanis, M.D., the project leader in Athens. He visited New York and Washington, giving us an opportunity to review the data and plan the next phase of the studies; and reporting to the staff of the Institute of his findings. He submitted a statement of his expenses for Athens-New York-Washington-New York Athens in May. \$825.

3. In our latest voucher (07, dated June 16, 1972), we requested the balance of the funds under this contract, and found that the balance left for overhead transfer was insufficient by \$ 1,222.

The pilot EEG data collected this spring was analyzed in New York, using machine time and personnel supported by NIMH grant MH 18172. Such additional costs, as well as supplies, incidental fees and travel, are not reimbursable.

My thanks for your cooperation and understanding in these negotiations.
