Thank you for your inquiry regarding the admission of your daughter to this Institute. I regret that we are unable to admit out-of-state residents directly to the Institute without the prior approval of the Director of the Division of Mental Diseases. Such permission is not ordinarily granted, except at the request of a Director of the State Services in which the patient may be a resident.

I believe you should know that two of the nation's finest research and treatment centers are in your State -- in Chicago, at the Illinois State Psychiatric Institute of which Dr. Lester H. Rudy is Director; and Galesburg State Research Hospital, Galesburg, Illinois, of which Dr. Harold E. Hinwisch is the Director of Research. I would recommend that you contact either of these institutions regarding your daughter.
