Floor T-1 - "Psychiatry"

The T-1 floor consists of a service core, and four quadrants. Following the architect's guidelines, the SW quadrant contains offices for the chairman, conference rooms, secretaries services, etc.

The remaining quadrants were designed for chemistry.

Quadrant SE contains the passage for connection to the hospital.

As an initial step, the following general assignments are recommended:

SW: Chairman, Conference, Lecture rooms, Clinical  
Psychology  
NW: Neurophysiology, Biological psychiatry  
NE: Biochemistry, physiology  
SE: Library, neuropsychology, psychophysiology

Should these designations be acceptable, many rooms require modification. At this time, deletions of permanent installed equipment are recommended for the following rooms:

- A. Delete central bench, hood, wall bench. Leave wall cabinets only if general purpose storage. Leave 110 v. outlets, minimum 2 each, 4 walls. Leave 1 HCW sink in appropriate corner.
- B. For cold room, leave shielding, wall bench and HCW sink. Delete DI, other benches.
- C. Delete all central benches, wall benches, except bench with all fixtures on one wall, preferably the unit designated F15, 203.

Remaining rooms to remain as planned.
