Dear George:

Late last spring, at the time when various members of the staff were completing their U.S. income taxes, the question occurred as to what provisions of the law applied to aliens, and the special provisions for those from certain countries. At that time, to assist us in the proper selection of salaries for visiting scientists, I requested Mr. Schnure to provide us with a short statement of the various visas and the impact these would have on salaries.
