Thank you very much for the contour maps of EEG spectra. Both Don and I found them quite interesting. In some ways, they are similar to the reports presented from UCLA. However, the possibility that relationships can be discerned in the bi-spectra which are not obvious in the usual spectral pictures makes this tool a most interesting one and we look forward to the further development of this program.

The sleep figure is probably the most important. However, despite my having looked at many sleep figures, I have worked so little in this field that I do not know how to comprehend the figure you present. Is it possible that in the future a single drug effect may be represented? If one could look at the effect of a common compound like a barbiturate or the intravenous administration of chlorpromazine, then I think it would communicate much more to people like myself!
