Dear Ralph,

I wish to confirm the telephone conversation of October 27. You will be pleased to know that Dr. Zaks has been successful in extending the duration of antagonism to heroin by naloxone. In a subject receiving 3 Gms/day, 26 mg heroin, 25 hours after the previous dose was experienced as a "blank", the subject exhibited neither behavioral, physiological or EEG signs of heroin administration.

Dr. Zaks was planning to retest the subject at 50 and perhaps at 75 mg (at 24 hours). This experience is very encouraging and I have asked Arthur to send you a detailed summary and a plan for continued study as soon as he completed the present series of experiments.
