Dear George,

Enclosed is a revised and updated summary of the high and low dose thiothixene data.

You will recall that some weeks ago you asked the data be reanalyzed using different subsets, as you noted that some patients had not been assigned to the appropriate groups. This has been done. Again we find that the high dose group has a significant change which may be ascribed to the drug effect, but that no differences occurred between the high and low dose groups.

Again, I would be pleased to go over the interpretation of this data with you after you have had a chance to digest it.
