Dear Miss La Rock:

It was a pleasure working with you last week and this is the first opportunity I have had to share with you our conclusions.

We will request first class accommodations (not deluxe) in Russia. I am willing to gamble on your associate's suggestion that if the accommodations are poor, we will go to Intourist and pay the difference.

We would like to go to Leningrad after Moscow and will plan to leave the meetings before their end. We would like to be in Moscow the evening of Thursday, August 4, taking the Paris to Moscow flight on Thursday morning. Given a choice I would prefer the Air France flight.

We would like to leave New York Tuesday evening, August 2, to spend the day of August 3, in Paris. Since the Moscow flight is an early one, would you arrange for accommodations in the airport hotel for Wednesday night, August 3.

We would like to go from Moscow to Leningrad by the midnight train on Monday night, August 8.

We would like reservations in Leningrad, August 9, 10 and 11. On Friday, August 12, we would like reservations from Moscow to Vienna. To do so, we will either have to get back to Moscow late Thursday night, unless you can arrange an early morning flight from Leningrad to Moscow that will make this connection. The connection Vienna - Istanbul should also be made for Friday afternoon.

Our tickets should include stopovers in Athens and Rome and our original plan for a flight from Rome to New York is reaffirmed.
