Thank you for sending the reprint on the analysis of eye movements. It came at a particularly opportune time, for I have just reviewed a report from the Chicago group of Holzman, Levy, et al., who measured eye tracking of schizophrenics as the subjects followed a pendulum. They used hand measurements for their scoring, and I was wondering whether there was not some way of measuring this task more precisely.

I was delighted to see that you had developed a method, and I am writing to ask whether I might see a copy of the Hawley report on the method, and the progress report on the effect of alcohol. (Did alcohol affect the saccadic measures, and if so, at what dose and time after ingestion?)
